

In this luxurious triplex in Hyderabad customised for its occupants, NA Architects has crafted a unique design solution weaving together modern technology with vernacular design principles, while keeping the contemporary context in focus, at all times.

The impressive scale of the home presents itself at the entrance foyer - designed as a courtyard with a massive tree! The courtyard is actually a three-storey void with a skylight on top. The sunlight streaming in through the skylight gets diffused as it reaches the living spaces; thus, cutting out glare and harshness. The tree had to be brought in by a large team and getting it to stand in place was a huge challenge. A customised stone installation here further enhances the powerful volume.

The design program includes a drawing room, the main living area adjacent to the kitchen and dining space and four spacious bedrooms. The master bedroom is a lavish space with a walk-in closet and all the trappings of luxury living. The children's room is a lively, fun space that is designed to encourage their innate skills and creativity.



Keeping the lower floor more for public use, most of the private family areas and bedrooms have been taken on the upper levels. The upper levels are accessed by a bespoke open steel and timber staircase which also becomes a stunning visual element in the drawing room. The home theatre which was a specific requirement in the client brief is placed strategically accessible for the public and private areas.

Beautifully landscaped open spaces (sit-outs) interspersed with the enclosed living spaces on all levels, help recreate the indoor-outdoor experience of bungalow life in an apartment.
